“CHRISTINE SINCLAIR DAY”

WHEREAS Christine Margaret Sinclair, OC OBC OLY, born in Burnaby, British Columbia on June 12, 1983, began her illustrious football career at four years old on the turf fields of the city; and

WHEREAS “Sinc” has tallied over 330 international appearances over 24 years as captain of the Canadian national team, is the world’s all-time leader for international goals scored with 190 goals, is an Olympic gold medalist and 2-time Olympic bronze medalist, is the second player to ever score in five different World Cups; and

WHEREAS Through Christine’s hard work and commitment, has inspired a nation to kick a football for the first time, to fight for gender equality, and is a leading advocate for Multiple Sclerosis awareness and research; and

WHEREAS Christine plays in her final international match with the Canadian national team on December 5, 2023 at BC Place in Vancouver, British Columbia.
