I have been a resident of Southlands, Deering Island since 1998, and am extremely concerned with the placement of the Iona White proposal location. The local placement is completely against the Southlands Plan of 1997 which proposed houses, farming & residential development with limitations.

Not only is there going to be significant noise with the new placement, but as a Practising Psychologist I want to draw your attention to noise, and noise sensitivity in the psychological coping of children, adults & the elderly. Noise is negatively associated with problem behavior, especially aggressive reactions to frustration. Further more research into noise has been associated with development of psychological symptoms.

I would strongly urge that this much needed \$10 billion project should be placed away from residential areas
