SUBJECT: CI - CAPITAL PROJECTS DELIVERY SERVICES - COLLIERS

PROJECT LEADERS INC.

PURPOSE: To obtain Council approval to award a Contract Increase (CI) for

Capital Projects Delivery Services - Colliers Project Leaders Inc.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT a contract increase to Colliers Project Leaders Inc. for an estimated total cost of \$750,005 including GST in the amount of \$35,715 as outlined in the Council Report titled "CI - Capital Projects Delivery Services – Colliers Project Leaders Inc." dated for January 29, 2024 be approved; and

THAT final payment will be based on the actual quantity of services delivered and hourly rates as submitted.

1.0 POLICY SECTION

The City's Change Order Policy requires Council's approval for change orders, which individually or when accumulated with prior change orders, increases the total value of the contract by \$1,000,000.

2.0 BACKGROUND

On August 29, 2022 the City awarded a contract to Colliers Project Leaders Inc. for the professional services to support City's Lands and Facilities and Engineering departments, such as acting on behalf of the City as representatives to help with planning, management and delivery of capital infrastructure, and civic facility projects within their intended scope, schedule and budget as stipulated in the capital plan, for an estimated value of \$4,548,625 including GST in the amount of \$216,602.

Since the award of this contract, there have been two change orders for a total amount of \$999,995 including GST in the amount of \$47,619 due to additional work required to continue supporting the additional capital projects.

A sample of the key capital projects that were included as part of the contract award are:

- New RCMP Detachment
- Animal Shelter
- Burnaby District Energy System
- Deer Lake Childcare (Christine Sinclair Centre)
- Confederation Park Community Centre
- Deer Lake Signage and Wayfinding
- Celeste Redman Community Amenity Space
- Christine Sinclair Signage
- James Cowan Theatre
- West Building Staff Relocation
- City Lands Inventory and Strategy

3.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

This contract increase of \$750,005 including GST in the amount of \$35,715, is required based on the current number of Colliers Project Leaders Inc. staff supporting Lands and Facilities and their typical weekly hours, this original contract is fully spent requiring an increase to continue to complete current projects. Lands and Facilities management have completed an assessment of the resources needed to complete this ongoing work with internal City of Burnaby staff and have included the staff requests to Council in the 2024-2028 Financial Plan. This analysis is based on capital project resource needs to complete projects in the near term. This fee increase is recommended to complete planned work up to the end of the contract.

City staff have reviewed the contract increase and believe it appropriately addresses our needs at a competitive cost.

The total estimated contract value will be \$6,298,625 including GST in the amount of \$299,935.
