Dear Mayor and Council,
I am an active user of the Barnett Marine Park. I often launch my kayak from there.

Your by-law #9527 says that:

"park user" means a person who is in a park for the purpose of participating in a function or using or enjoying a facility therein and does not include a person who leaves a motor vehicle in a park while he or she attends at premises outside the park.

3. (1) No person other than a park user shall park a motor vehicle in a park

(3) No person shall park a motor vehicle in a park in contravention of a sign that prohibits parking or that limits the time during which a motor vehicle may be legally parked.

I have been told that these bylaws prohibit anyone from parking overnight in the lot.

This is a real problem for those of us who like to paddle up to Granite Falls and stay overnight. There used to be some parking options outside the park but they have all been eliminated.

Could you please consider finding a way to make it possible for us to park in the lot overnight when we are on a trip? I am thinking a simple time limited permit system could work.

I look forward to working with you to find a solution.
