3.1 Burnaby Heritage Designation Bylaw No. 1, 2024 - Bylaw No. 14639

Eagle Ford Neon Sign

4160 Albert Street (alias 4191 Hastings Street)

Purpose: to provide for the protection of the Eagle Ford Neon Sign and add this to the list of Burnaby Community Heritage Register as a heritage landmark and also enable variances to the City's Zoning Bylaw to permit its installation on a City-owned sidewalk on Hastings Street
