Who Uses Heritage Burnaby?

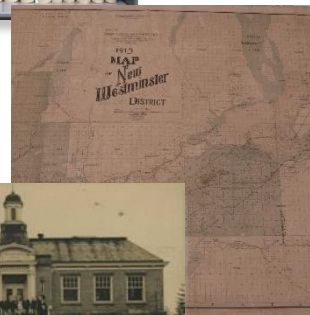
- City Staff

- Local historians

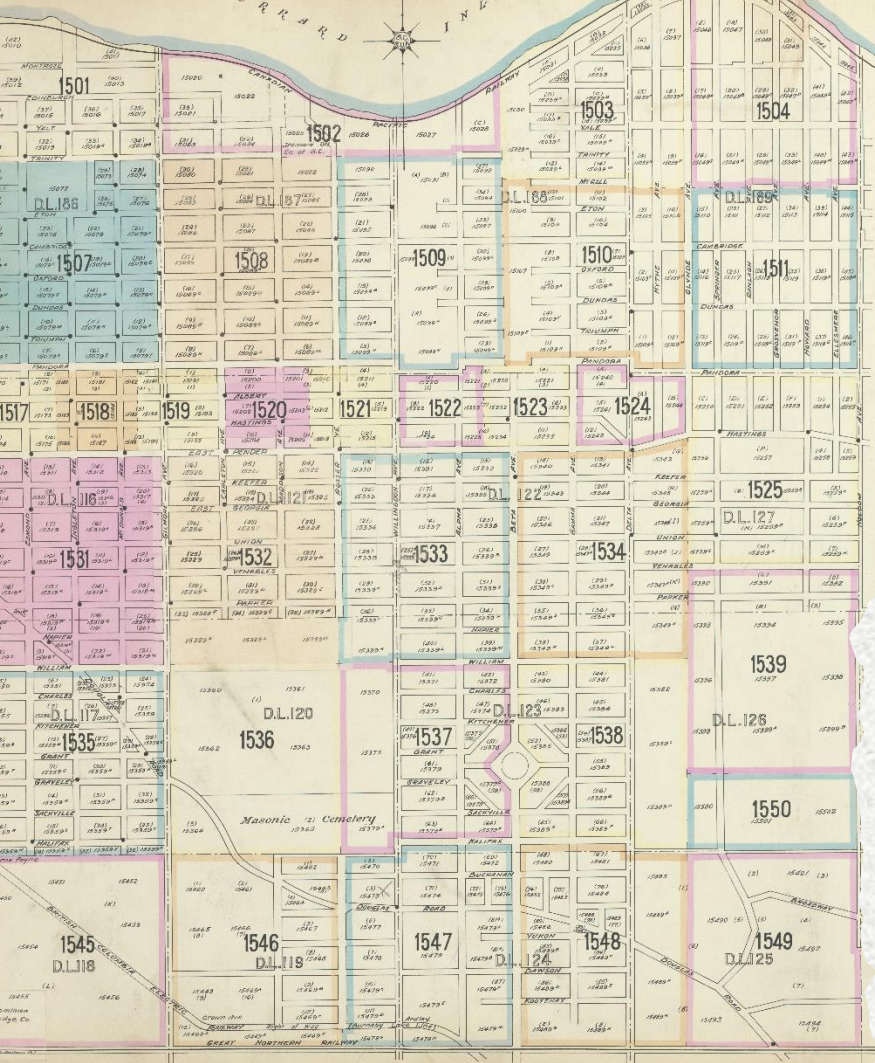
What is Heritage Burnaby?
