

**CITY OF BURNABY**

**BYLAW NO. 14664**

A BYLAW to close and remove the dedication of  
a certain portion of highway

WHEREAS pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter* and section 120 of the *Land Title Act*, Council may by bylaw close part of a highway to traffic and remove the dedication of that part of the highway;

AND WHEREAS Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic and remove the dedication of that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HIGHWAY CLOSURE BYLAW NO. 3, 2024.**
2. ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as the portion of road dedicated on Plan BCP26417 containing 1,849 m<sup>2</sup> of District Lots 2 and 4, Group 1, New Westminster District, as shown outlined in bold and identified as Parcel A on Reference Plan EPP136469 (hereinafter called “the closed portion of road”), prepared by Gary Sundvick, B.C.L.S., a copy of which is hereunto annexed, is hereby closed to all types of traffic.
