- Endorsed by Council in September 2021
- Each factor is scored on a scale of 1 to 10
- Scores are tabulated and assigned to every block segment in the City
- The higher the score, the higher the prioritization need

- » traffic calming features, such as curb bulges, where appropriate
- » upgraded street lights to improve visibility for people using sidewalks and roads
- » new concrete driveway ramps
