
# 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue Pedestrian Crosswalk (12<sup>th</sup> Ave and Canada Way)

This is not a concern about Canada Way. This is a concern about <u>12 Avenue Pedestrian Crosswalk</u> that is situated next to Canada Way. It has been identified as a "HOT SPOT" and poorly designed of 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Canada Way.

**Improvement** would be a 4-way pedestrian light and 4-way traffic light like Burris and Canada Way. Police Incident: **2024-801780**.

Quick Fix: Adding a right turn only sign and someone to survey the area and witness the area.





#### Attachment 1

**Problem:** Motorists are failing to come to a complete stop at the intersection, often rushing to beat the traffic light. This behaviour poses a significant safety risk to pedestrians crossing the road, especially school children. Parents and the school have requested an officer's visit to monitor the situation and help mitigate the potential for a fatality.

# **Suggested Improvements:**

- Have a Surveyor monitor the number of car not yielding to the stop sign.
- Add signage of children crossing or school nearby
- Add signage must stop at stop sign
- Add signage "right turn only between 7 AM to 9:30 AM Mon to Fri" like Knight St and 61st Ave
- Mark the pedestrian cross walk with white lines
- Close 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue to bicycle route only

**Results for Solution provided:** Elementary Student will be safer walking independently to school than before. Reduction in cars in the area because parents are walking their kids to school. Significantly reduce the chance of fatalities.





Image 4: Map of Canada Way and 12th Avenue.

# **Twelfth Avenue Elementary School**

As you can see on the lined black area is the catchment for the Twelfth Avenue Elementary students and lined blue are the students that are required to walk or get to school safely by crossing 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Canada Way.

The walking path for students in red from 16th Avenue to Twelfth Avenue. The student would walk down 7<sup>th</sup> St, cross 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue on Canada Way, cross 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue on Canada Way, and finally safely crossing Canada Way with the Crossing Guard to Twelfth Avenue Elementary School.

As the school hours are from 9 am to 3 pm, a lot of children are walking by themselves to school.

# **RCMP Reported**



A school constable visited in October 2023 (incident # 2023-801668), and a police officer visited earlier this year, with a patrol car parked at the location, potentially deterring speeders. However, despite these efforts, many vehicles continue to exhibit this behaviour, endangering the safety of Twelfth Avenue students and staff.

  - o Response: Thanks for reaching out to Transportation. There are plans for <u>curb extensions at 12th</u> Avenue and Hilda Street to shorten the crossing distance and increase visibility for pedestrians. The curb extensions will begin design in 2025 with construction to follow. As for 12th Avenue and Canada Way, there are plans for a full signal upgrade in the next 2 years as part of the Southeast Bikeway Improvements project.

As part of the Burnaby Elementary School Traffic and Safety Study, the project team engaged with the school principal and PAC members if available to better understand the school area's existing challenges and opportunities for improvements.
