ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Key accomplishments in 2024 from Phases 1 and 2 of the **HOME Strategy include:**

- » adoption of Small Scale Multi-Unit Housing regulations (action 1.1a and 1.1b)
- » completion of two-year review of the Tenant Assistance Policy (TAP) (action 9.1)
- » implementation of the recommendations from the development approvals review (action 1.2)
- » Council endorsement of the Final Report from the Mayor's Task Force on Unsheltered Community
- » establishment of the Burnaby Housing Authority Board of Directors (action 10.1)


