


PRELIMINARY FINDINGS

- Daily trips: 555,200
- Daily kilometers travelled: 4,249,500
- Destinations:
 - 62% within the City
 - 38% outside of the City
- Average household size: 2.40
- Average household car ownership: 1.36
- Transit and active transportation mode split:
 - 36.7% Citywide
 - Over 44% at most Town Centres
