RECOMMENDATION

THAT the language for the plaque to be installed at Jack Crosby Sports Box at Riverway, as outlined in section 3 of the report titled "Jack Crosby Sports Box Official Opening Plaque", dated April 7, 2025, be approved.

1.0 POLICY SECTION

Official Opening plaques are installed in facilities to commemorate the official reopening of a facility that has undergone substantial renovations or significant additions. They recognize the Council's leadership in enhancing citizens' quality of life through major infrastructure developments and acknowledge funding partnerships and contributions from various partners, including other levels of government.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Section 2.4 of the Terms of Reference for the Executive Committee of Council require the Committee to review and recommend to Council the wording and content for commemorative plaques that are to be installed in parks, civic buildings and facilities.

On January 22, 2008, at the age of 66, Jack Crosby, Burnaby's "Mr. Lacrosse", passed away. In recognition of the contribution Jack Crosby made to community sport in Burnaby, especially the development of the sport of lacrosse, the Parks, Names and Signs Committee recommend to Commission that the new outdoor box lacrosse facility at Riverway Sports Complex be named "Jack Crosby Memorial Lacrosse Box". A dedication ceremony was scheduled for late spring 2008 at the Riverway Sport Complex and the plaque went missing. This report presents the text for the grand opening plaque and dedication plaque at Riverway Sports Complex.

3.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

The newly renovated Jack Crosby Sports Box at Riverway was open to the public on April 22, 2024, and the grand re-opening originally planned for fall 2024 but was

postponed to better align with the Lacrosse community's schedule and availability to participate. The grand re-opening ribbon cutting and photo opportunity event will be held on Saturday, May 3, 2025, from 10:00am to 11:00am at the Jack Crosby Sports Box at Riverway located at 8605 Nelson Ave, Burnaby.
