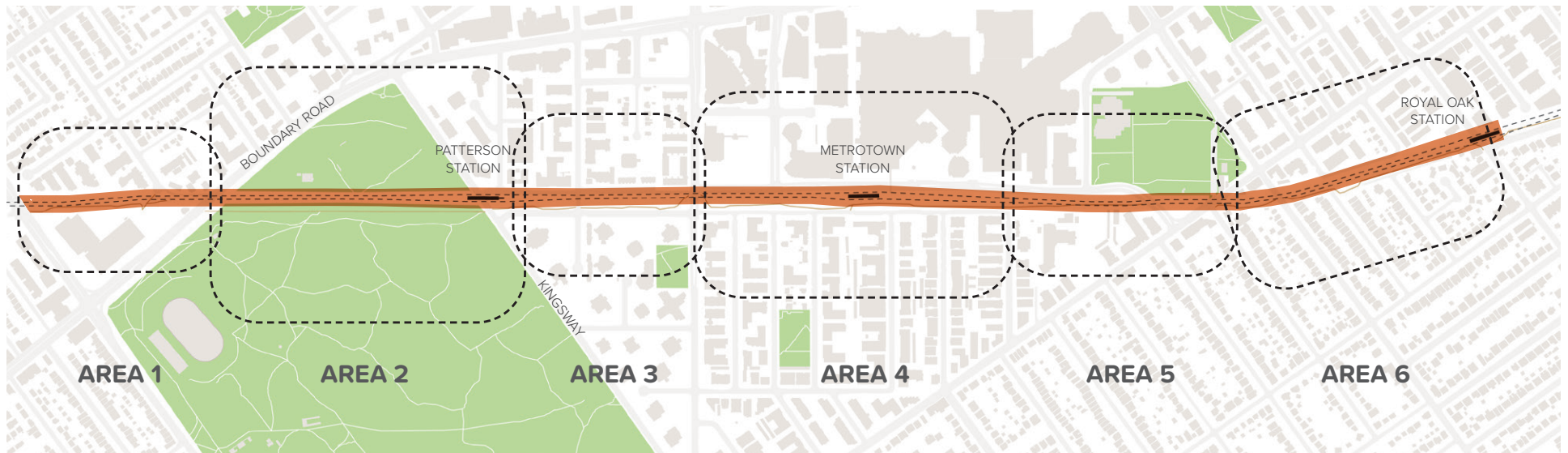
INTERACTIVE MAP ACTIVITY

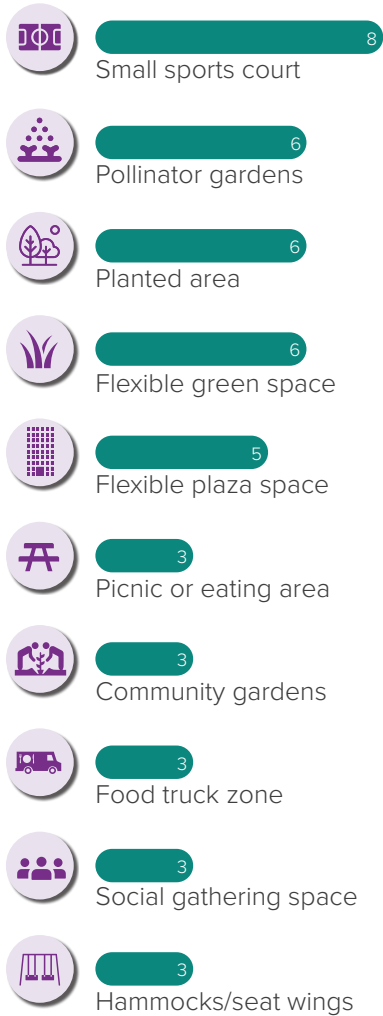


Area 1 - Boundary Road to Kingsway

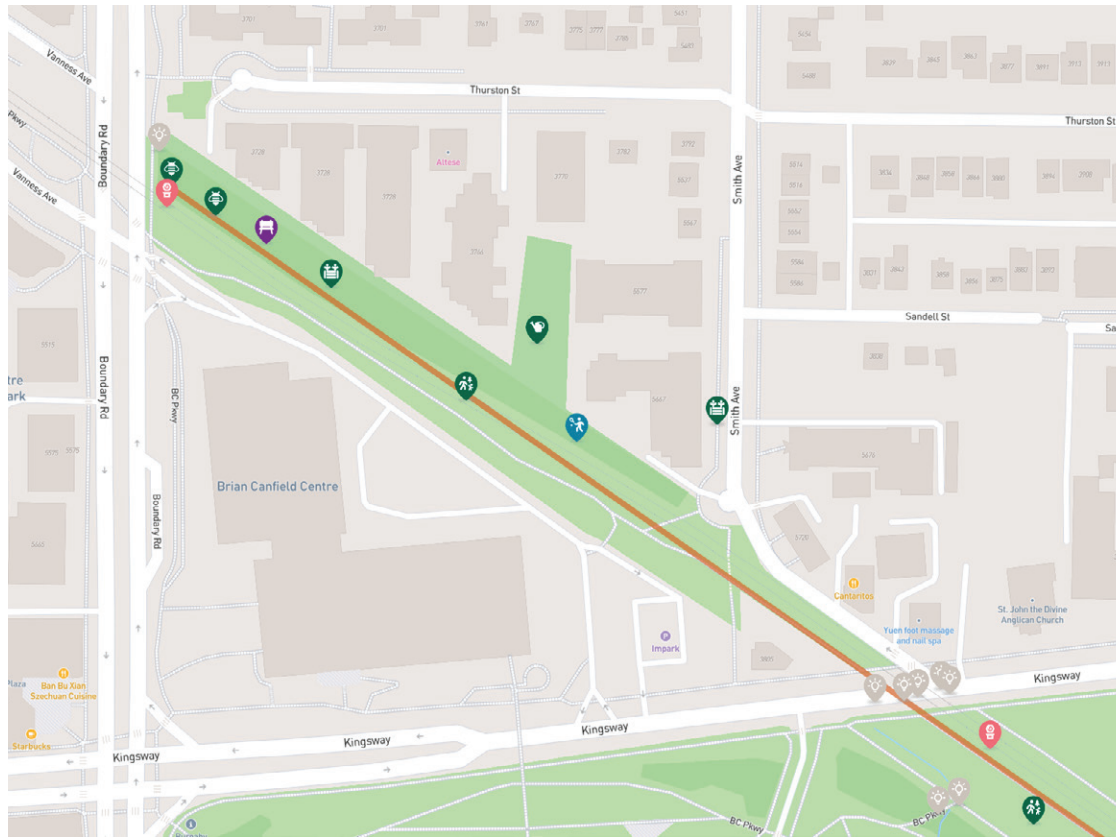

EMERGING VISION

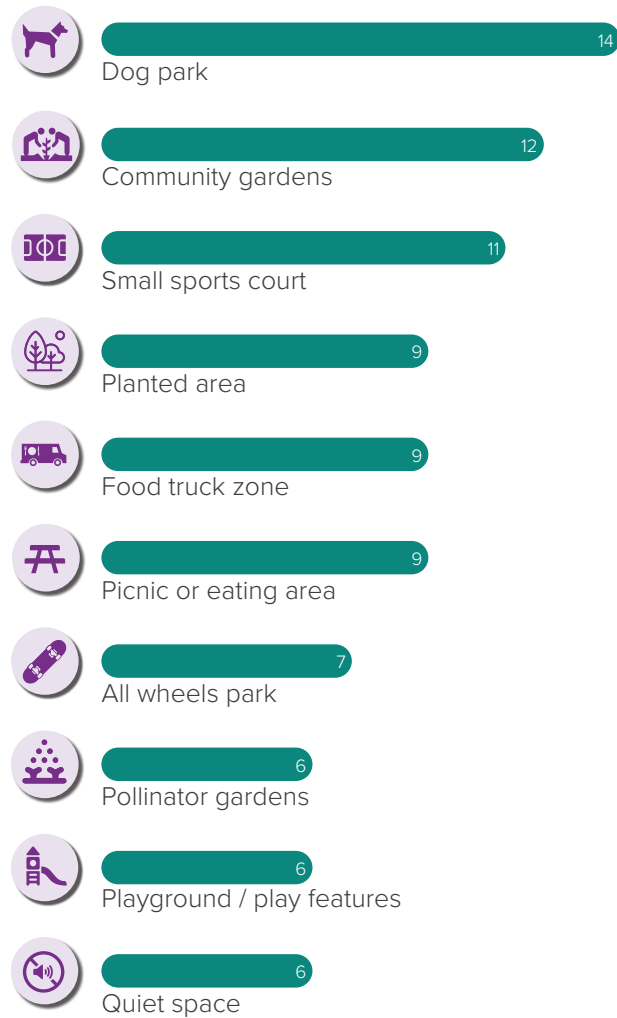

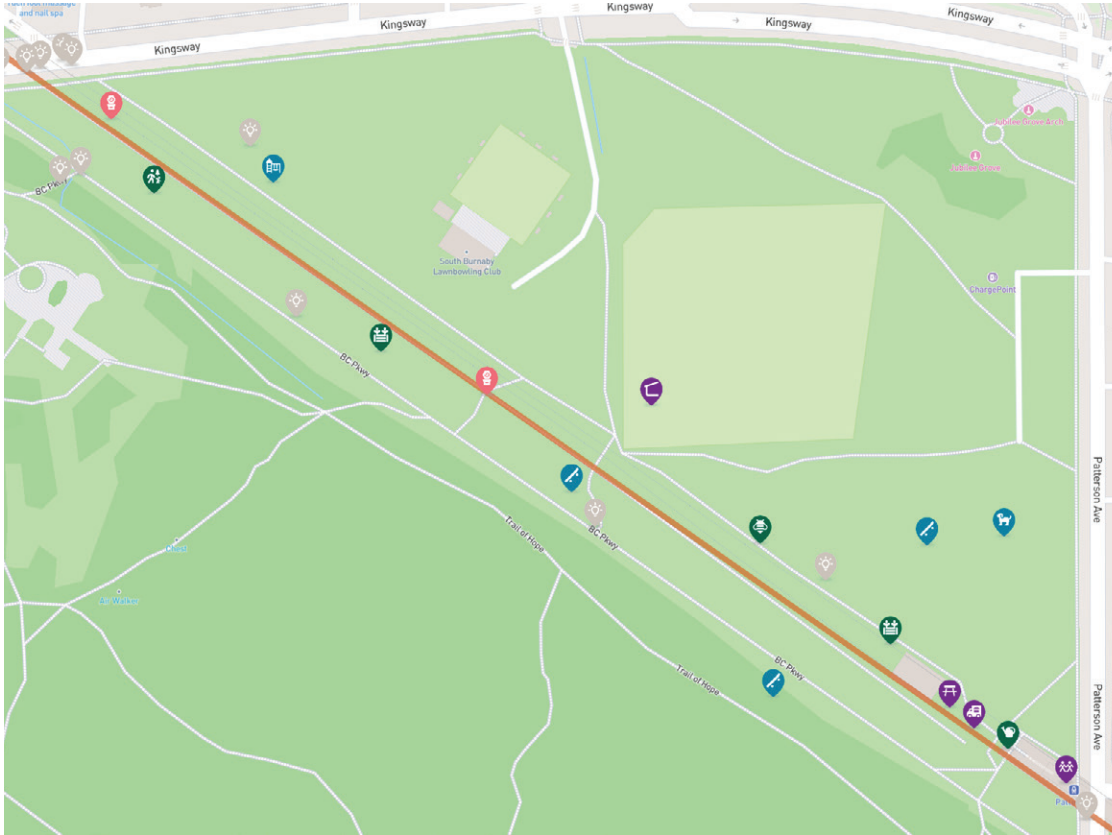
