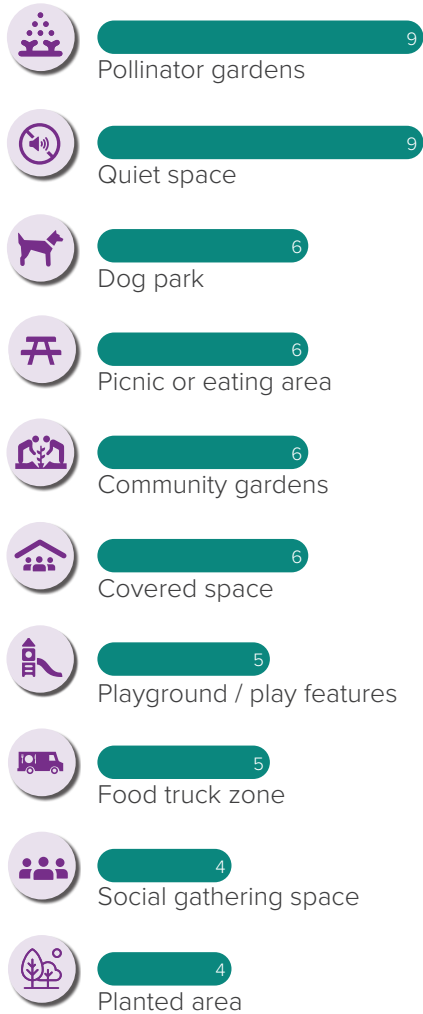


Area 3 - Patterson Avenue to Willingdon Avenue

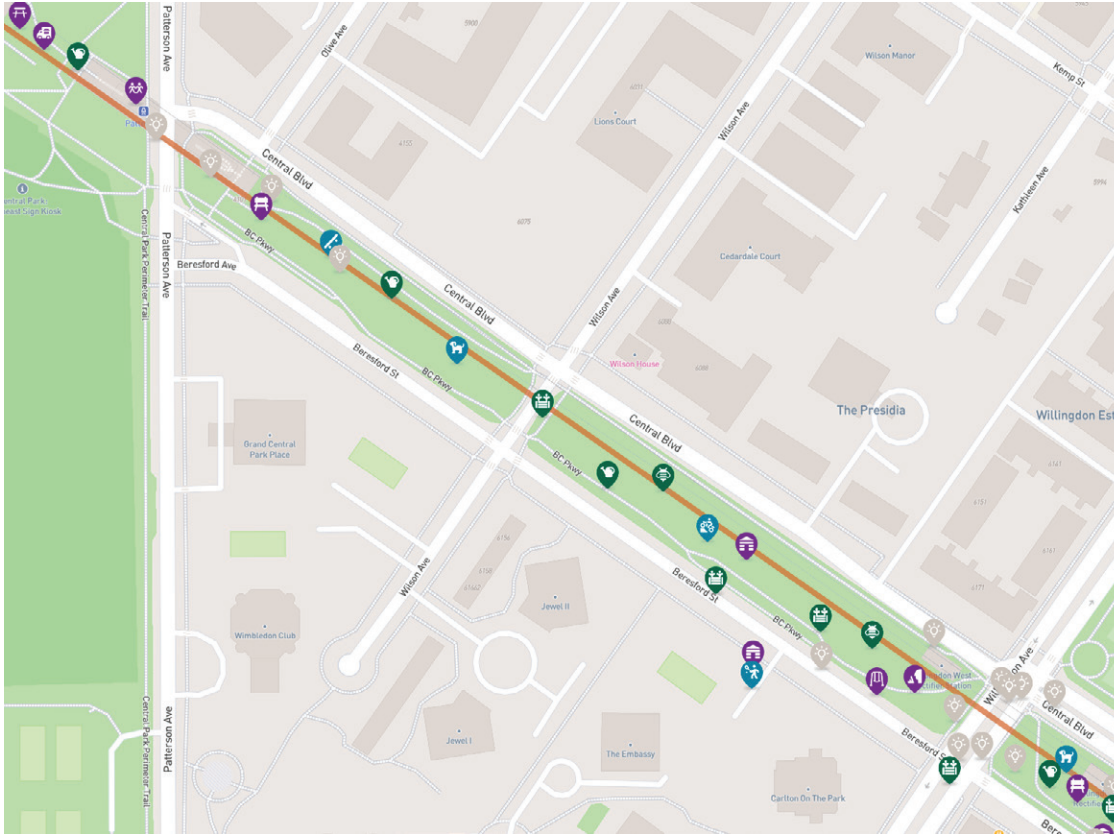

EMERGING VISION

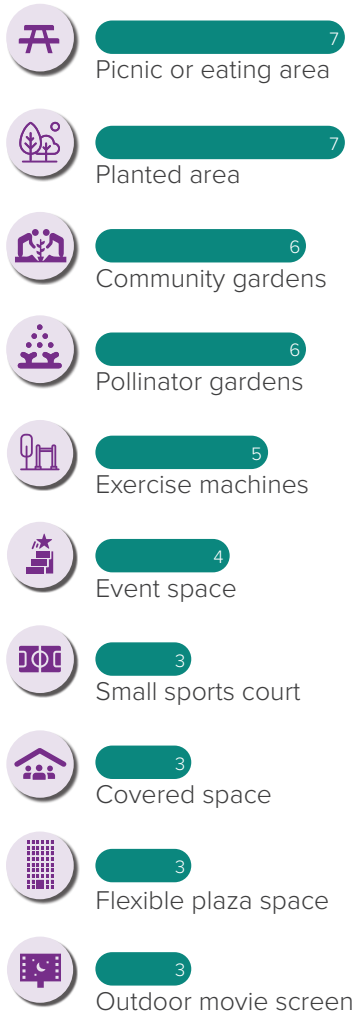
A place for local residents to gather, play, and enhance wellbeing;

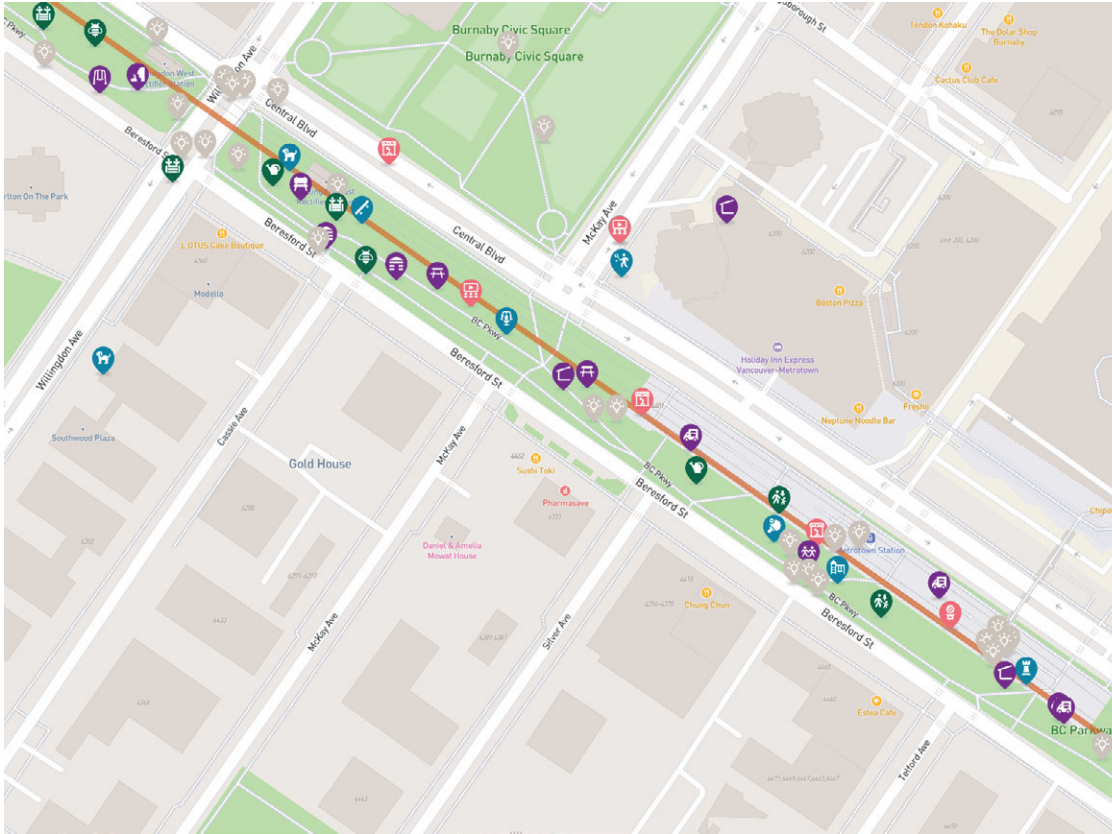

EMERGING VISION

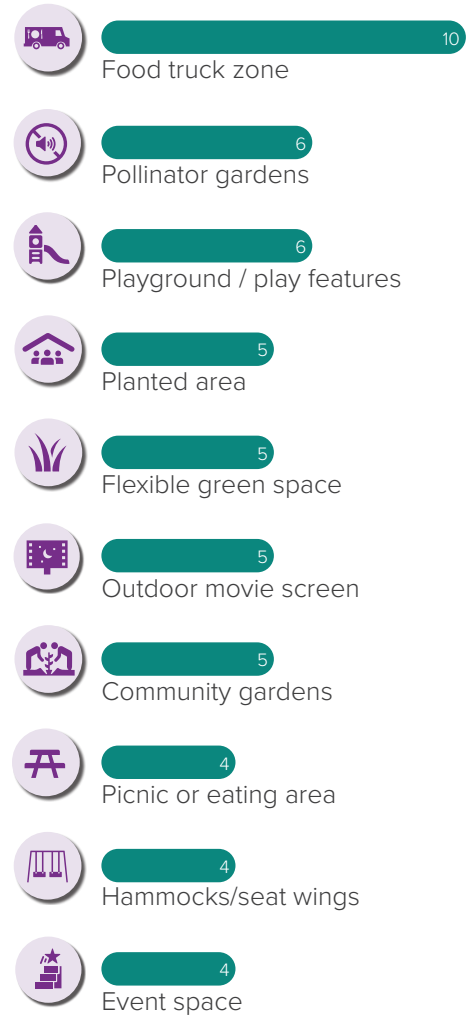
A buzzing place for entertainment, shopping, lounging and socializing;

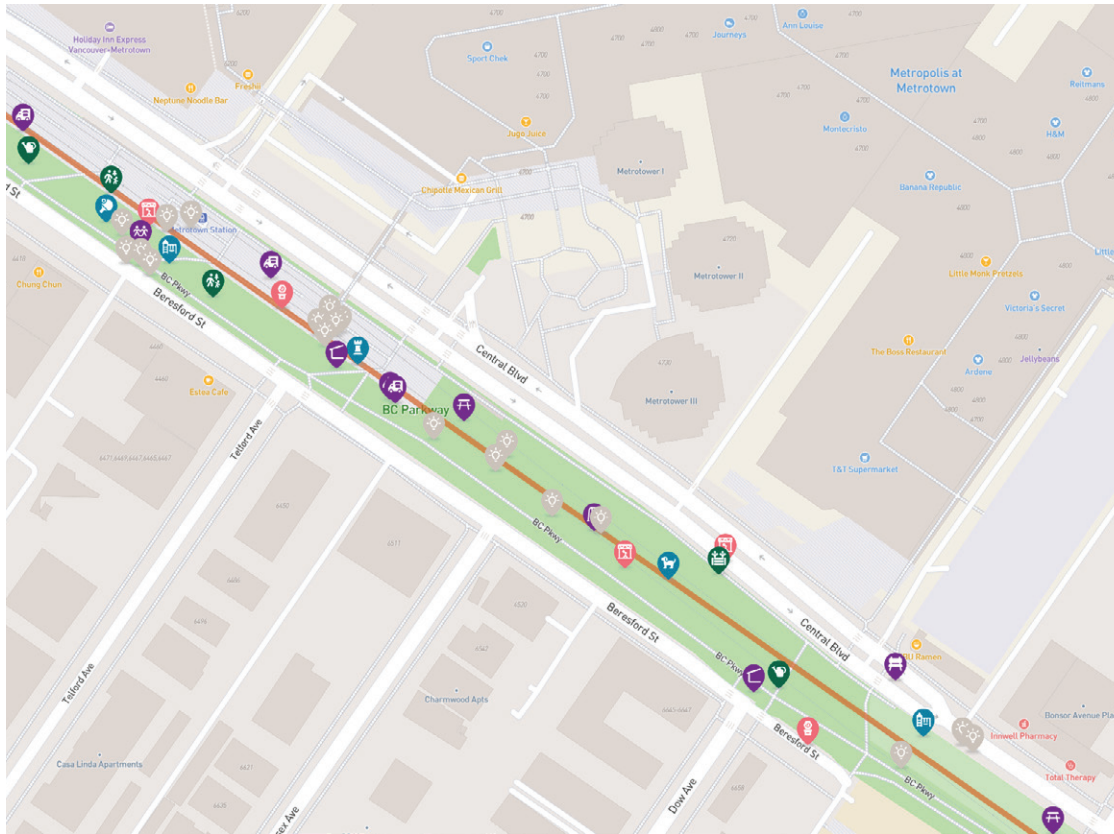
