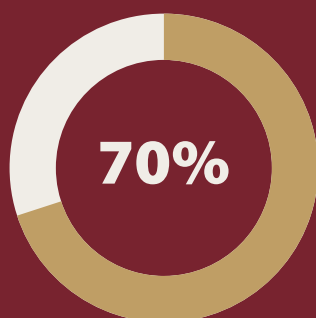

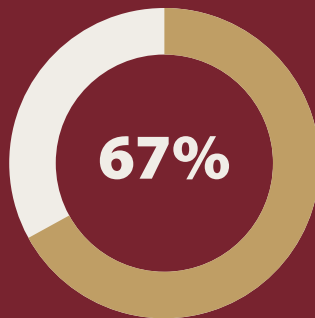

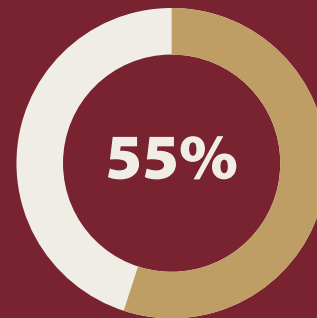

Support for Actions

The majority of respondents support:

- reporting on urban forest data and progress
- increased staffing and service delivery to fund urban forestry services
- reviewing the Civic Tree Reserve Fund to ensure tree planting and maintenance costs are covered
- 10-year tree planting program for parks and streets

What We Heard

- exploring internal and external funding sources to implement the strategy
- updating landscaping requirements and the Tree Bylaw
- including parks and trees in asset management
- setting minimum canopy cover targets by land use
- involving the community in stewardship
