BYLAW NO. 14750**

A BYLAW to amend
Burnaby Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY CONSOLIDATED FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2, 2025.**
2. Burnaby Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw as amended, is further amended:

3. Subsections 2(a) to (f) of this bylaw come into force and effect on July 1, 2025.
4. Subsections 2(g) and (h) of this bylaw comes into force and effect on September 1, 2025.
