The City had three retirements, and one person consented to share their information.

Christine Ensing

Christine retired from employment with the City on April 30, 2025, after 26 years of service. She commenced employment with Burnaby on December 20, 1999 with the Planning and Development Department. From July 1, 2021 to her retirement, Christine held the position of Climate Action and Energy Specialist.

MAY RETIREMENTS

The City had four retirements, and two people consented to share their information.

Margaret Manifold

Margaret retired from employment with the City on May 28, 2025, after 17 years of service. She commenced employment with Burnaby on April 21, 2008, with the Planning and Development Department. From February 10, 2014 to her retirement, Margaret held the position of Planner 3.

Lorenzo Pettenon

Lorenzo retired from employment with the City on May 28, 2025, after 27 years of service. He commenced employment with Burnaby on November 16, 1998, with the Fire Department. From September 27, 2021 to his retirement, Lorenzo held the position of Fire Captain.
