SUBJECT: REFER TO STAFF: CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS ON STONEY CREEK – PROPOSED MITIGATION MEASURES

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the recommendation of the delegation at the Environment Committee meeting held on February 9, 2026, in regard to mitigation measures for Stoney Creek, be **REFERRED** to staff to conduct a feasibility review and report back to the Environment Committee at a future meeting.

REPORT

The Environment Committee, at its meeting held on February 9, 2026, received a delegation from Suzana Kovacic, presenting data on pollution in Stoney Creek and proposing specific mitigation measures. The delegation requested that the City:

- initiate work and public consultation on Official Community Plan Policy Action 5.3.3;
- hold off where possible on approving development applications in the Stoney Creek Watershed until there is a bylaw change with more stringent requirements, including permits that require updated technology; and
- utilize the Erosion and Sediment Control permits to implement validated technology to protect Stoney Creek for existing applications.

Arising from the discussion, the Committee adopted the above noted recommendation that the delegation's concerns be **REFERRED** to staff to report back at a future Committee meeting.

The recommendation is now before Council for final approval.
