

To Mayor and Councils of Burnaby and other relevant government officials of BC:

Petition Opposing the 3020 Gilmore Shelter

We, the undersigned residents and community members, oppose the proposed drug-permitted shelter at 3020 Gilmore. This location is unsuitable and will bring serious safety, crime, and public-disorder risks to the neighbourhood. A shelter that accepts active drug users will place our children, seniors and neighborhood at great risk, and will turn this area into a second Hastings, and Metrotown will face the same decline seen around Vancouver's Chinatown. The project lacks transparency, proper consultation, and a clear safety plan.

We respectfully request that the City of Burnaby, BC Housing, and the Province of BC halt this project, conduct full community consultation, and consider alternative locations and treatment-focused models that do not endanger nearby residents, businesses, and public spaces.
