1.0 POLICY SECTION

2.0 BACKGROUND

Burnaby RCMP detachment is represented at the Public Safety Committee by the Officer in Charge (OIC). The Public Safety Committee Terms of Reference outline the RCMP role in the Committee which includes:

- providing leadership to and support for the activities of the district Community Policing Advisory Committees and other volunteers; and
- review, provide feedback and forward recommendations to Council on a variety of matters related to the implementation of and citizen involvement with community and problem-oriented policing.

As a result, at each meeting of the Public Safety Committee, the OIC provides a detailed report covering highlights from the previous quarter.

3.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

RCMP submit a report to the Public Safety Committee, which provides updates and highlights from various initiatives as well as traffic and crime statistics (Attachment1).

In addition, a copy of the detachment's APP quarterly report is submitted to the Public Safety Committee (Attachment 2).

4.0 COMMUNICATION AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

This report provides information on the Burnaby RCMP Online Crime Reporting that was launched in 2020 and continues to be used by members of the public. An average of approximately 200 reports is received during each report period. The online reporting makes it easier for people to file certain non-emergency complaints.
